Message from Financial Aid Department



All students that are currently attending Dade Medical College must provide a copy of their 2008 Federal Income taxes by June 30th, 2009. The new academic award year will start on July 1st, 2009, so all students must submit their tax information to the Financial Aid Department before that date. All students must also provide the school with a complete FASFA form. If a student did not file a 2008 tax return, they need to provide the school with another form of income for that year. Avoid being withdrawn or affected with higher monthly payments by turning in all necessary information on time. For more information, visit the Financial Aid Department at either campus.
