Keiser University to Offer First of Its Kind Master's Degree in Education Specializing in Career College Administration

Fort Lauderdale, FL—Apr. 16--Keiser University now offers the career college community its first master's degree that specializes in career college administration. The Master of Science in Education in Career College Administration is the first of its kind according to Chancellor, Arthur Keiser, Ph.D. This program provides educational leadership training to the thousands of career college administrators heretofore unable to receive a master's in their chosen career field.
