DOCUMENTS

Transcripts: An official transcript, sent by your high school, reflecting seven consecutive semesters of high school and a cumulative unweighted GPA of 2.0 or higher. Photocopies will not be accepted.

Essay: Each applicant is required to submit a 300 word minimum essay. Each of the following three questions must be answered with a minimum of 100 words per question:

- 1. Why have you chosen this particular career?**
- 2. How will this program of study help you obtain that career?**
- 3. Why do you want to attend this particular institution?**

If you are electing to mail in your application the essay must be typewritten on standard 8 ½ x 11 sized paper and must include your name, address, and high school name in the upper left-hand corner. The essay must be signed by the applicant. **No hand written essays will be accepted.** Applicants applying for multiple scholarships must submit a separate essay for each scholarship application.

NOTIFICATIONS

FAPSC nomination committee will review students' applications. Letters of notification will be sent to all applicants notifying them if they were awarded a scholarship. **All scholarships are provided by the participating institution and the recipient must meet all admission requirements of the awarding institution.**

Unfortunately, the FAPSC staff cannot provide information as to why a student was not selected as a scholarship recipient.

AWARDING

Scholarship award amounts vary depending on the scholarship type. Some scholarships are for full tuition costs and others are partial tuition scholarships in the amount of \$5,000 and \$1,000. Full tuition scholarships cover the cost of tuition whereas partial scholarships are a one-time award in the amount of \$5,000 and \$1,000. Registration, processing fees, books, lab charges, and student activity fees are not covered by the scholarship and are to be paid by the student. The costs vary depending on the institution and course of study. Please contact the individual institution directly about what is included in their scholarship. **Awards are disbursed directly by the institution.** Scholarships may only be used for the 2012-2013 academic year, and may not be applied toward tuition to a future academic year. **Scholarship awards are not transferable.**

INSTRUCTIONS

To apply for a scholarship, applicants must complete the scholarship application and essay.

Materials must be received by FAPSC no later than April 6, 2012. Applications can be completed online and submitted from our website electronically at www.FAPSC.org

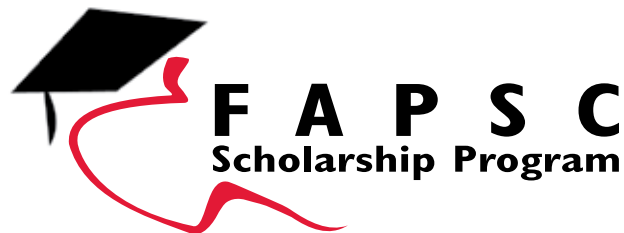
